### Introduction

```
shows exigence of the issue
shows exigence of the piece analyzed
provides needed background
moves to thesis (general to specific)

#### Thesis statement

concise arguable impersonal

analytical, follows our pattern: the piece accomplishes x through y

# Body paragraphs

topic sentences
refer to the thesis
cover what follows
evidence

supports the thesis directly proceeds logically

with appropriate transitions

is logical in itself

features short, frequent quotations

blended well

supporting main ideas

not interfering with student's own voice

### Conclusion

redefines thesis (doesn't *restate*) moves from specific to general suggests implications or future questions (without going so far as to posit a new thesis)

## Style

writing is grammatical, showing conversance with standard discourse no fragments, run-ons, comma splices writing is effective, showing authority and persuasion concise, effectively constructed sentences; strong word choice
